The animal pictures include one (the first) done whilst Peter was at Art School in 1954 was produced using a 'scrapboard' technique.

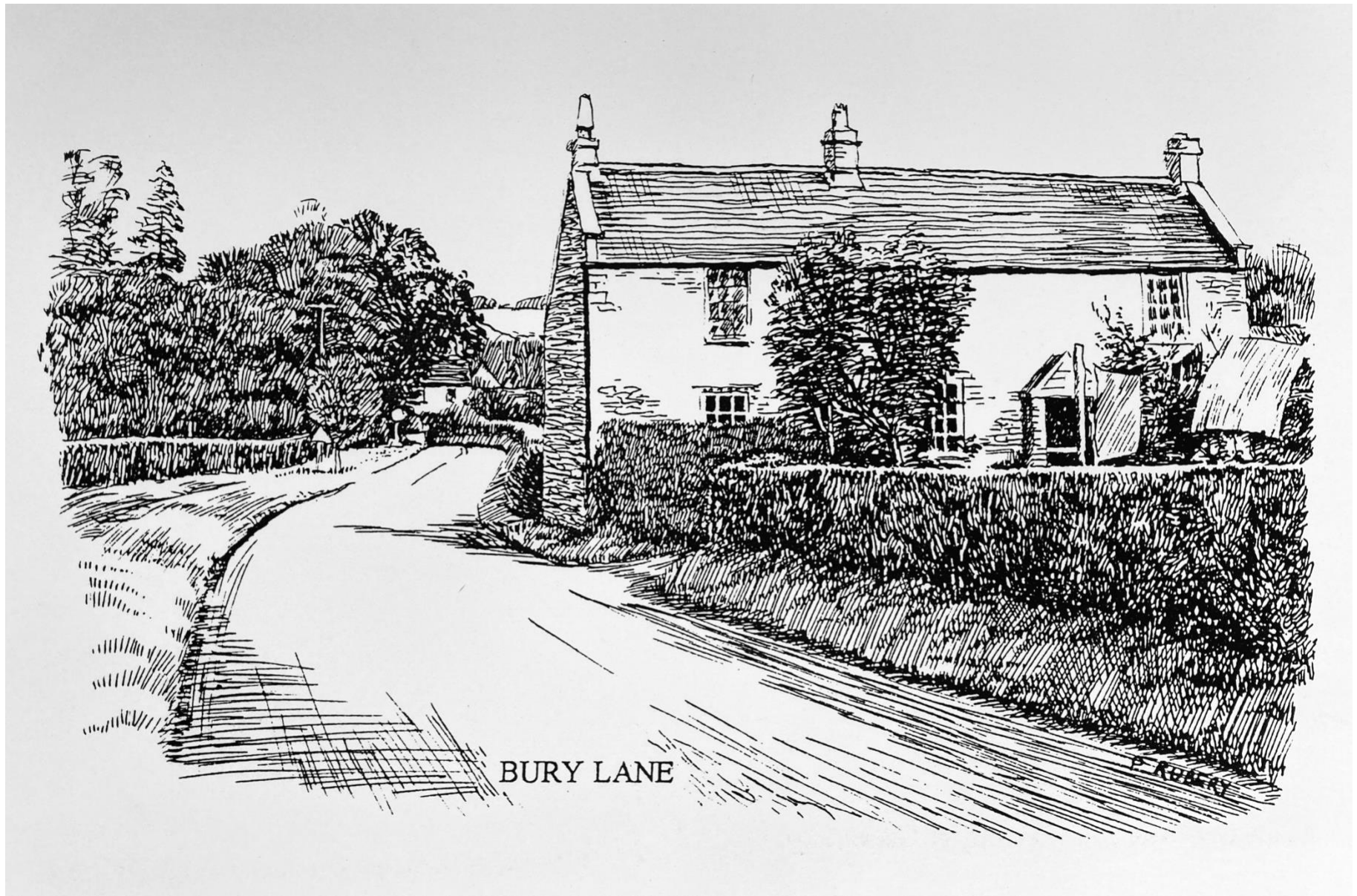

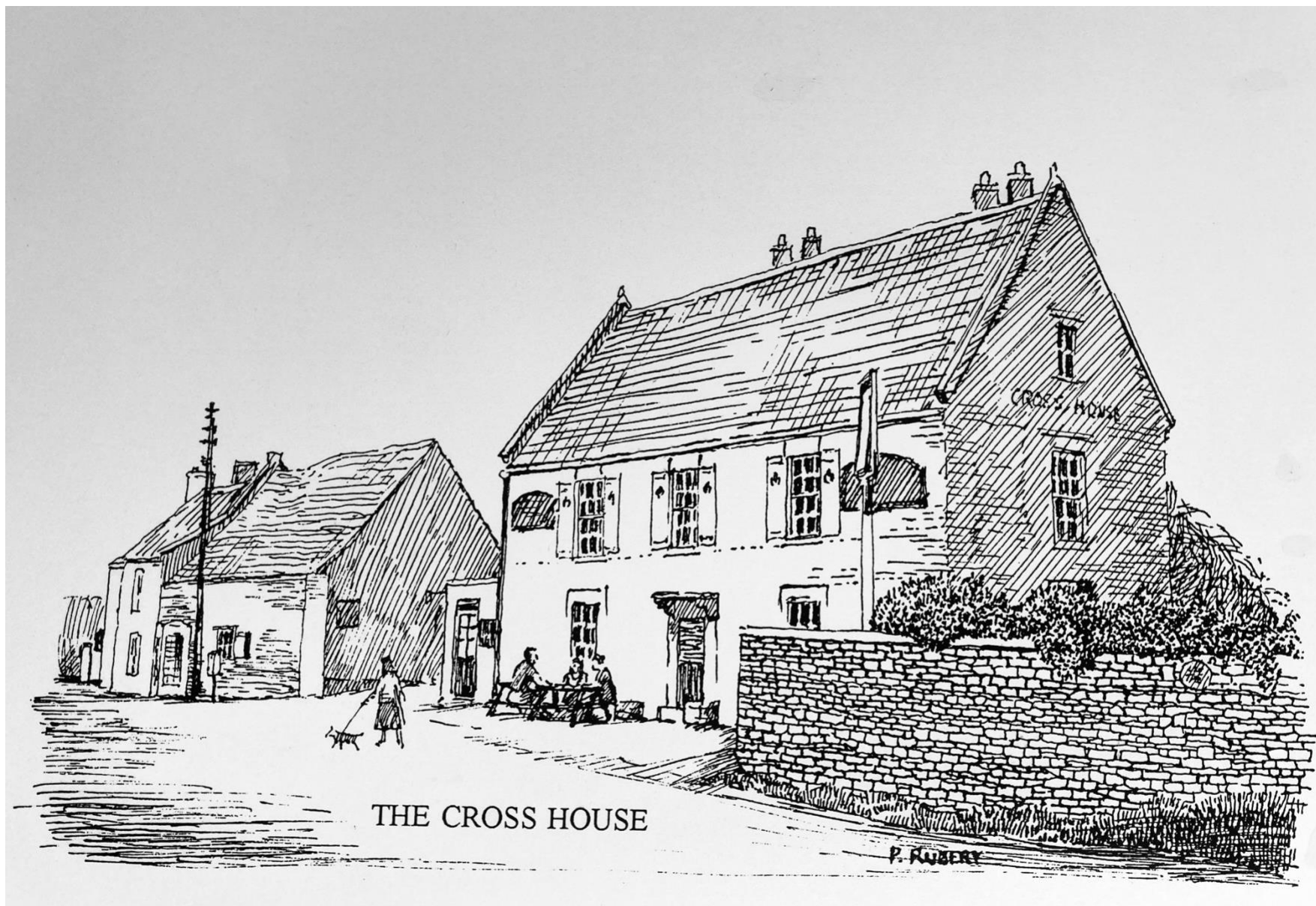

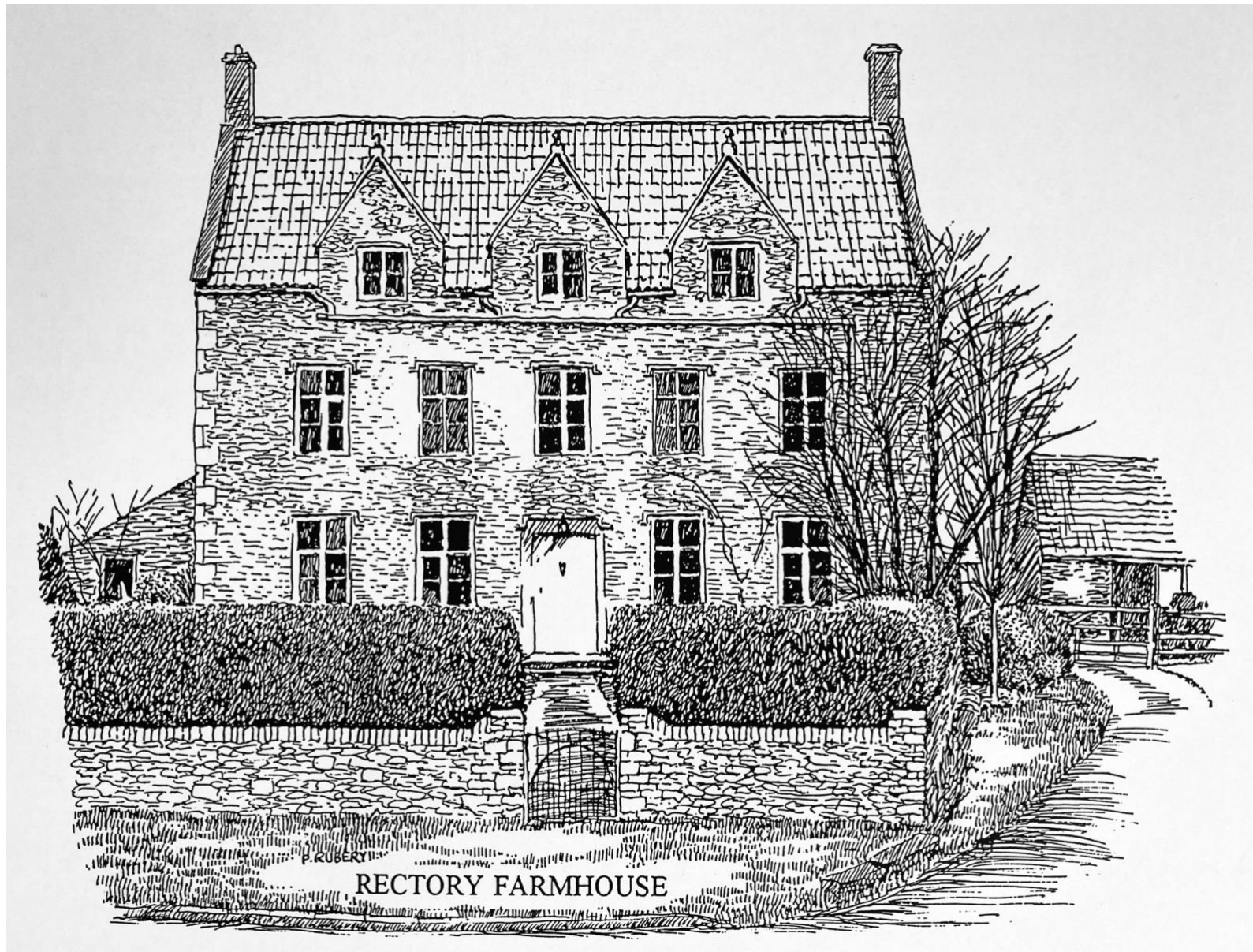
