- 7.2.1 After clearance of the payments noted above, the working capital balance at HSBC Bank for the month to 31st July 2021 will be £6,277.90 which includes earmarked funds of £184.90 for the maintenance of the defibrillator and £292.86 VAT refund from HMRC for 2020/21. The balance on the S106 savings account currently stands at £14,564.13.

- 8.1.1 The complaint re the Potholes and the danger to motorists/cyclists on Cullysgate lane due to its degrading will be further escalated. EW
- The manhole breaking up on Bury Lane outside Doynton House and Mill Lane pothole repairs will be chased again. EW
- The Clerk to thank Highways for the improvement to the Slow road markings on the High Street however the white lines have not been completed on the latter. EW
- The clerk will ask when the grass verges are to be cut as Doynton has not had its first cut this year EW
