5. **Issues for discussion.** 5.1 Road Safety Issues in the Parish are ongoing, however Stephen Reade the District Councillor advised Doynton is on SGC investigation list for 20 mph limit through the village. Cllr. Hart reiterated the white lines in the High Street since added in 2021 have been a success in slowing traffic and that further 30 mph roundels on the ground on Bury Lane are due to be completed in 2022 by SGC. Residents are reminded to report surface damage on roads direct to the SGC website.
