**6.1 To Comment on Planning Applications**

**PK16/4041/TCA** Cumbria Church Road Doynton

Works to crown reduce lno. Blue Atlas Cedar by 1-2m, clearance of 1m to be given around electric wires, re-pollard lno. Norway maple and Crown reduce lno. Box Elder by 0.75m in Doynton Conservation Area.

T2 Norway Maple - advanced decay at base, re-pollard to reduce risk of failure under wind loading.

T3 Box Elder - Crown reduce by 0.75m and shape to leave pleasing appearance

**PK16/3615/TCA.** Court Barton, Church Road, Doynton. Works to fell lno. Purple Birch, crown reduce and thin by up to 50% lno. Silver Birch and reduce crown by 30% of lno. Cedar tree all situated within the Doynton Conservation Area. *No Objection.* **PK16/3828/LB.** Wayside Cottage, High Street, Doynton. Internal & external alterations to facilitate the refurbishment of existing, and the erection of a two storey rear extension. *No Objection.*

**PK16/3827/F.** Wayside Cottage, High Street, Doynton. Erection of two storey rear extension to provide additional living accommodation. *No Objection.* **PK16/3090/F** 3 Church Road Doynton. Erection of single storey and two storey rear extension to provide additional living accommodation and installation of Juliet balcony *No Objection.*

**PK16/3615/TCA** Court Barton Church Road Doynton Works to fell 16no Scots Pine trees. Situated in the Doynton Conservation Area. *No Objection.*

**PK16/2296/PNA** Rookery Farm Rookery Lane Doynton. Prior notification of the intention to erect lno. Agricultural building for storage of fodder and machinery.
