8 VILLAGE MAINTENANCE & HIGHWAYS.

Update on problems already reported to SGC unless stated.

The blocked drain by Vine cottage on the junction with Bury Lane and High Street, continues to be chased by District Cllrs. Reade and Stokes.

Replacement road signage on Bury Lane and Bury Lane on the corner with Culleysgate lane is now in situ and the potholes have been repaired on Mill and Rookery Lanes.

8.1.2 Highways
Traffic calming measures to Bury Lane awaiting completion continue to be monitored by the clerk and the refreshing of the White lining on Bury Lane after Close and Home Farm being chased by District Cllr. Reade.

8.2 New Issues raised by Councillors.

A couple of Street cleaning and Maintenance projects have been assigned to a small team under Dave Jones at SGC which will be undertaken end March/April. A large Pothole on Ham Lane by the gas sign near the stables at the top end to be reported by the clerk along with the very dangerous state Culleysgate Lane is now in. A road closure sign would be advisable stating "Access only" coupled with the removal of the Doynton Signpost from the A420 directing traffic down Culleysgate lane as it is virtually impassable. DPC has been warning SGC of the degrading due in much part to the drainage problems for many years.
