It's five years since the community orchard and wildflower meadow was established. The apple, pear, plum and cherry trees are growing well and it's great to see so many people using and enjoying this beautiful space.

At the Friends of Summers Field AGM in April, we reported on the management committee's activities and the financial position of the charity as at end of 2016. We were successful in securing a small grant from the South Glos Council Member Award towards the upkeep of Summers Field and raised funds through events. Over the past year, our general maintenance of the field continued and we improved the fencing at the north boundary. In early May, members of the committee took part in a working day to mow the paths, pick up litter, instal signs to discourage dog fouling and strim around the trees and boundaries.

We welcome your support in helping us to maintain and nurture the field as a space for the community to enjoy. Our annual outgoings are around £1,500 per year and we continue to seek donations and membership contributions towards this amount. We recently delivered membership forms to many homes in the village and the form is also attached for anyone who would like to make a donation or be a member of the interest group this year.
